Dear Year 7 Parents and Carers,

Further to our communication on Wednesday, in preparing for the new week and reviewing staffing absence, I have needed to take the decision to extend the closure of the Sheerness campus to Year 7 for a further day on **Monday, 7th February**. To note, this includes Year 7 students who attend our Brabazon provision.

I would like to reassure you such a decision is not taken lightly, with all possibilities exhausted before being made. I will review again Monday and an update provided to you ahead of Tuesday.

The timetable for Monday will be circulated separately ahead of the first lesson starting on Monday at 9.30 am. We will continue with the pattern of three lessons over the day to ensure screen fatigue is avoided.

Your child will be invited to a remote lesson which they are able to access through Teams. They will not need to know which band they are in and will be able to simply accept the invitation from the member of staff who is leading the session. Please note this may NOT be the teacher your child normally has, nonetheless they are subject specialists and teach year 7. A register will be taken at the end of the lesson.
