

Behaviour in the classroom

REFLECT - 1st Warning - verbal

Teacher will issue you a warning regarding your behaviour.



ENGAGE - 2nd Warning – name on board

You have not changed your behaviour and the teacher will remind you of the poor choice. Your name will be written on the board.



CHOICE – to change your behaviour

At the third offence, you will be given a direct verbal choice; stay in the classroom and behave appropriately or exit the class for a RESET (30 minute detention)

Disruptive behaviour in the classroom

If your behaviour is disruptive and does not meet the expectations of the academy you will be sanctioned according to the four point scale.
