Dear Head Teacher/Governors/Parent/Carers,

Re: Determination of Admission Arrangements for 2022 for Oasis Academy Isle of Sheppey.

Consultation took place between 18th December 2020 and 31st January 2021 on Oasis Academy Isle of Sheppey's proposed admission arrangements for 2022. The proposed change was to reduce the academy's Published Admissions Number (PAN) to 270. No changes to the oversubscription criteria were proposed.

As part of the consultation, emails were written and distributed to parents/carers, local schools, local community groups and the Kent Local Authority.

There were two objections received during the consultation. Oasis Community Learning has made the decision to not reduce the academy's PAN and it will remain at 390. The Admissions Arrangements have now been formally determined by the Oasis Community Learning Board.
