Dear Parent/Carer

Re: End of Term

We are writing to thank you for your support and working with us to ensure your child is engaged with the high quality remote learning we have been setting since the school closure in March. It has been a challenging time for all stakeholders and we have had to adapt quickly to a completely new way of working. We are incredibly grateful to all our staff for their hard work during these challenging times. They have worked tirelessly to log attendance and ensure all students are safe daily; learn how to use MS Teams remotely and record lessons for students to access; deliver live lessons from home; and prepare work packs for those with limited or no internet access. We have also had many staff planning and delivering sessions to those students who have been on site throughout this period, as well as staff in the community delivering food parcels to families most in need.

As we edge closer to the end of term, we would like to clarify that term ends on Wednesday 22nd July. However Monday 20th, Tuesday 21st and Wednesday 22nd will be staff INSET days to allow our staff body to prepare the school building and curriculum for September and ensure all our students have the best possible return. For this reason, no remote learning will be sent next week although mentor emails will continue in the mornings, please continue to answer these. The academy will remain open for key worker children until the last day of term. We will close for the summer from 12pm on Wednesday 22nd July. Parents of children attending on the last day of term will need to arrange for their journey home at this time.
